

Internet Safety for Youth – Empowerment in Cyberspace

The TUNNE (Turvallinen nuorten netti) project provides Finnish families with information that encourages constructive and ethical use of the Internet. TUNNE is the Finnish representative in the European Safer Internet network INSAFE. TUNNE is run by The Mannerheim League for Child Welfare in years 2005-2007.



Themes: Media skills on the net, source criticism, social contacts, cyberbullying, addiction, e-privacy, gaming, responsibilities and rights

Actions: Parental evenings, lessons for pupils, teacher trainings, online materials, surveys, material for peer student instructors, co-operation with national and international organizations (e.g. Safer Internet Day)
